CIVIC ENGAGEMENT

Under the CIVIC ENGAGEMENT Campaign and in a collaborative effort between Southerners on New Ground and Mijente centered their work around counties where the Latinx community live: Cobb and Gwinnett counties.

GLAHR canvassed 4,668 houses, providing Soy Georgia information as a reminder to exercise their right to vote. GLAHR, with support from volunteers, organized eight community events in preparation for the June 9th primaries in the State of Georgia. In the middle of the COVID-19 pandemic, we continued targeting these two counties through organic phone banking, reaching a total of 37,904 individuals, 22,234 in Gwinnett and 15,670 in Cobb.

Call to Action HB 994 // 1083 Legislation Session 2020

This year's legislative work continued its partnership with Project South, Women Watch Africa, Inc., the Black Alliance for Just Immigration and Unitarian Universalist, we held a training for legislative lobbying, which led to our annual Lobby Day to advocate against HBs 1083, 994 and HB896.

Remaining vigilant of bad legislation, GLAHR tracked three bills that would have made a detrimental impact on the lives of young Black and Brown people if passed. We had the Governor's much-touted House Bill (HB) 994, labeled as the "Youth Criminalization Bill" to counter the messaging that this is an "anti-gang bill."

This bill would result in longer sentences and harsher penalties for individuals suspected of gang activities, carving out larger grounds for what is considered gang activities. The "Youth Criminalization Bill" would target/arrest individuals based on what they are wearing, whether it be specific colors or being indirectly associated with certain individuals, which can result in additional charges.

CALL TO ACTION



HB 994: Youth Criminalization

- Call your legislators to vote NO on HB 994, which makes it easier to criminalize youth as young as 13 years-old. It will result in more Black and Brown people targeted by law enforcement and it extends the time individuals are sentenced.

HB1083: Anti-Sanctuary

VETO HB 838 VETO SB 402

GLAHR remained committed to organizing and mobilizing anti-immigrant bills and efforts to further criminalization. GLAHR is actively co-working with a larger coalition of immigrant rights and criminal justice organizations to see the defeat of two harmful bills:

HB 838, Anti-BLM bill that will allow first responders and Local Law enforcement to file lawsuits against groups, individuals, and organizations for damages and/or intimidation.

SB402 would eliminate signature bonds, forcing individuals to pre-trial arrest and would make the cash bail process permanent and make it impossible for poor people to get out of jail. The bill would unjustly target Black and Brown communities.

In collaboration with SONG, RJAC, and Project South, we created a petition, phone banked, participated in a vehicle caravan to Governor's Mansion, and made phone calls to the Governor's office for the veto of both bills. Both bills were passed by Georgia Congress.

BLACK LIVES MATTER MOVEMENT

Five days after the death of George Floyd, folks gathered to protest the way Atlanta Police Dept. (APD) was handling the protests in Atlanta, so we headed to the Governor's Mansion along with ATLRadical Art to demand Justice for Black Lives.

In continuance with supporting the Black Lives Matter (BLM) Movement, our legal team supported individuals, some of which resulted in hundreds of people getting arrested and being taken to Atlanta City Detention Center (ACDC).

In solidarity with BLM, we joined some of the mobilizations in the Atlanta area as we understand the struggle to find Justice for Black lives involves us all.






Latinx for Black Lives Matter BLACK/BROWN Unity

GLAHR co-organized two mobilizations for Black Lives Matter in collaboration with Krazy Batos on June 20th around ICE courts with No More Cages, Defund the Police, and in support of the Black Lives Matter movement.

On July 4th a second mobilization took place in collaboration with Latinx Youth in Lawrenceville, GA in support of the Black Lives Matter, defund the police and abolish ICE demands. Vibrant youth interest in looking to get involved and advocate for the human rights of communities of color.





International Union of Painters and Allied Trades (IUPAT) Picket Line

Before COVID-19, GLAHR and the International Union of Painters and Allied Trades (IUPAT), held a wage theft picket line in solidarity with the unjust firing of a worker. The worker did not receive his job back nor could he create a union to support his coworkers but he was able to obtain compensation for the unjust firing. Our work with IUPAT is to uplift both worker and immigrant rights. Along with IUPAT, we held wage theft clinics to keep the community informed on their rights as workers as well as workshops.



Free To Move Campaign

(Raising Political Awareness with the Georgia Latino Alliance for Human Rights)


The Freedom of Movement national campaign was a collaboration among GLAHR, Mijente and Lush Cosmetics to raise awareness about the Immigration system in the U.S, and the injustices immigrants are faced with on a daily basis.



An important demand under this campaign was to make the call for the support of The New Way Forward act which will “*restore due process for immigrants; ban privately-owned, for-profit detention camps; end local collaboration between police and immigration agents...*” while repealing sections 1325 and 1326 of the immigration law that criminalizes border crossing whilst maintaining civil deportation procedures.




The month of May seemed to be filled with caravans and community activities. GLAHR participated in a May Day Caravan around the city of Atlanta to garner the attention that the working class was being faced with the possibility of evictions, loss of jobs, and lack of security.

At a times where the amount of Covid cases are increasing, and Georgia's governor was not putting the people first, instead of demanding businesses to be closed due to the high rate of infections, he chose to blame the workers for being put at risk.





COMMUNITIES OVER CAGES

Over the past two years, GLAHR along with Women on the Rise, Racial Justice Action Center (RJAC), SONG, Project South, Black Alliance for Just Immigration (BAJI), Women Watch Afrika, Solutions Not Punishment (SNPco), among others have fought for the closing of Atlanta City Detention Center.

On April 2020 Mayor Bottoms proposed 18 million dollars be allocated to a nearly empty detention center. We co-organized and were able to push Mayor Bottoms and City Council to re-assign the majority of the budget and approved a 3 million dollar budget to help and facilitate the relocation of ACDC employees.

STOP \$23 Million Jail Expansion

Fulton County's Sheriff Ted Jackson requested a \$23 million dollars to expand Fulton County Jail, arguing COVID-19 people detained needed to be spread out. Our collaborative work such phone calls, and mobilizations resulted in the cancellation of the request the Jail Expansion budget was assigned to better needs of Fulton residents.



FREE THEM ALL CAMPAIGN

As part of the national mobilization and in continuation of GLAHR's grassroots organizing and advocacy against mass incarceration and mass deportation of communities of color, we partnered with Georgia Detention Watch, Detention Watch Network, Project South, and Siembra NC to demand ICE Free them ALL before the COVID-19 arrival to detention centers.

Due a history of health complaints and lack of medical assistance there wasn't any guarantee on the safety and well-being of immigrants in detention at Stewart, Irwin, Deyton, and Folkston. We produced and released some videos to elevate the detainee's demands.

All four detention centers, located in small rural areas of Georgia, many of which have limited access to hospitals. In the early phases of the pandemic, some with higher risk were released, but no other relief was implemented.



Irwin Detention Center Caravan

In collaboration with Project South and the Georgia Detention Watch, we participated in a caravan at Irwin County Detention Center as part of the #FreeThemAll campaign to call attention to the COVID-19 cases inside ICDC.

Our caravan occurred the same day in which elected officials went to inspect ICDC, deeming it safe or unsafe due to COVID-19, and although their findings are controversial in regard to the number of individuals infected, we will continue to demand they stop harming the immigrant community and close down ICDC.



"LIBEREN A TODOS" #XMAP IN PLAINSIGHT: LOOK UP!

As a collaborative effort with #XMAP - nationwide artists.

In Plain Sight a collective of 80 artists, displayed a "Liberen a Todos" (Free Them All), a sky typing message broadcast over the city of Atlanta (Piedmont Park).

On July 4th we organized a small action outside the Stewart Detention Center along with members of Georgia Detention Watch.

The message was displayed the following day, July 5th, at Piedmont Park.





Shut Down ICDC

GLAHR worked with Project South, Georgia Detention Watch, and the South Georgia Immigrant Support Network, to file a federal complaint against LaSalle Corrections stating that the company was failing to properly protect detainees and employees from COVID-19 in detention centers, specifically Irwin County Detention Center. Our complaint was formed thanks to Dawn Wooten, a nurse at Irwin, that spoke out about what she witnessed within the detention center. The complaint garnered national attention.

IMMIGRATION BOND FUND

GLAHR was given the opportunity to lead and collaborate with local organizations and founders to create an Immigration Bond Fund.

The GA Immigration Bond Fund is utilized within the framework of ending immigration detention and Rapid Response to support organizing of individuals most-impacted by incarceration and criminalization.

The Bond Fund is also available to all individuals detained in Georgia and GLAHR remains committed to keep organizing individuals impacted by incarceration and immigration enforcement.

To aid with the support of the GA Immigration Bond Fund, we established public sites for donations, and in total, the GA Immigration Bond Fund has amassed \$146,465.84.

Under this COVID-19 period, we continue facilitating communication with members of the ComitesPopulares, many of which are 3 hours away. Our effort extended to members and individuals in South Carolina. GLAHR continue hosting, through social media outlets weekly calls since the 30th of March. GLAHR produced digital resources (videos and graphics) to alert members on COVID impact statewide under the campaign "No Pases la Tos, Pasa la Voz")


COVID-19 CAMPAIGN

COVID- 19 SUPPORT TO FAMILIES

COVID-19 has made a deep impact on the financial well-being of the community.

Through a series of calls to our Hotline and outreach, we identified community members in need of financial support. Donations came directly *"from the people for the people"* and included clothing donations.

GLAHR's financial assistance was able to support 12 families. Some of those recently lost their homes due to a fire in their apartment building. Two families needed aid due to the death and detention of their loved ones. Lastly, women-single mothers were helped economically whom had lost their jobs due to the pandemic to pay utilities bills. In total, 4,565 dollars were used to support the immigrant community when they had nowhere to turn.





END 287(g)

As we approached the renewal of the 287g agreements in Cobb and Gwinnett Counties, we held a week of actions, consisting of social media storms, we contacted county commissioners and posted on the Sheriff's social media. Fortunately, we have not seen the renewal of the 287g program in Cobb county, and are hoping for a more immigrant-friendly Sheriff once the elections come in November.




COMMUNITY ORGANIZING

END 287(g) 'DEPORTATION PIPELINE' Digital Forum

GLAHR, along with Georgia Detention Watch, SONG, Project South, and La Gente de Cobb, came together to hold an Immigration Pipeline Webinar to educate the community about the impact of the 287g program on immigrant communities. For years GLAHR has worked to inform the communities about programs like 287g, which we often refer to as an Immigration Pipeline with particular emphasis in two counties -Cobb and Gwinnett which are densely populated by the Latinx community.

As part of GLAHR Civic Engagement activities to educate communities about the importance of GOTV. GLAHR in collaboration with Mijente and Southerners on New Ground organized a series of Digital Town Hall meetings where Sheriff's candidates presented their positions in regard to issues that impact communities of color. In total, we reached 17,686 individuals with these forums.

Cobb County's Sheriff Neil Warren who didn't respond to our request hasn't signed the renewal of the 287g program in that county.

Gwinnett County is densely populated of Black and Latinx folks, often targeted by the police and sheriffs department. Gwinnett County Sheriff, Butch Conway, renewed the 287g program.



ICE FREE ZONE

Since its launch in 2016, GLAHR's ICE Free Zone campaign has been able to reach individuals by going to them instead of waiting for them to come to us with the purpose of educating the immigrant community and creating a culture of resistance. We have seen that the Latinx community are hard-working individuals who work and go home; consistency in attending meetings is something they do not all have the availability of doing, which is why GLAHR sees it as more convenient for us to go to them, which means canvassing at their apartment complexes, grocery stores, churches, and community events. Due to the coronavirus, we could only be out on the streets for a little less than a month. We were able to visit seven different stores and eight community events; informing 885 individuals about their constitutional rights.





ICE CHASERS

GLAHR's ICE Chasers is a rapid response team composed of members, allies, and faith groups who seek to inform and safeguard the immigrant community and defend them in case of ICE presence in an area heavily populated by the immigrant community. In connection with our ICE Free Zone campaign, we hosted know your rights workshops in areas with a heavy ICE presence.

Organizational Development

We had the opportunity to continue with staff capacity-building workshops and training before and during the pandemic. We were able to have 29 workshops in total from January to June. These workshops/training's included strategic planning for the year, Soy Georgia (civic engagement), #NoTechForICE, Census Organizing, Public Charge, Redistricting Strategies, A Decarceration response to COVID-19, the use of technology as a weapon against the immigrant community, the Stimulus Package Relief for Nonprofits, and the use of technology within the immigration system and capacitation for deportation defense.

Leadership Training

The focus of our leadership development is to build the skill of our members. This year we hosted various workshops on topics like the census, Public Charge, how voting machines work, and on our civic engagement work- Soy Georgia. Also, we hosted our weekly meeting calls and Asamblea with our comites populares.





Youth leadership 'GLAHR 'JOVENES'

The GLAHR Jovenes had the opportunity to meet 24 times this year, hosting their first-ever movie night via Zoom. The overall purpose of these meetings is to build new leadership of teenagers for social justice.

They have been able to participate in different discussions spanning from Black Lives Matter and the deaths of George Floyd and Ahmaud Arbery, the COVID-19 pandemic, and reproductive justice. The Jovenes also participated in actions at the Irwin Detention Center and the Atlanta City Detention Center and got to hear from various guest speakers like community member Rafa Solorzano, Dr. Alfredo Carlos, and speakers from the Highlander Center.




IMPACT LITIGATION - LEGAL HANDLES

GLAHR, along with our national partners Just Futures Law and Mijente, moved to seek transparency within our local government to reveal the ways people are being surveilled and tracked in Georgia.

GLAHR filed an open records request against the City of Atlanta for more information on its use of tracking software in light of the COVID-19 pandemic. We have sought records from the Sheriff's Offices in Cobb and Gwinnett counties that share databases with ICE.

GLAHR, Project South, and Innovation Law Lab began investigating whether there was a relationship between the Georgia Department of Drivers' Services (DDS) and Immigration & Customs Enforcement (ICE). Findings showed, between September of 2017 - June of 2019, DDS processed more than 250 requests from ICE and various other immigration enforcement agencies within the DHS to find information on hundreds of immigrants living in Georgia.

On March 18th, 2020, NBC News reported on our findings as the first source confirming the relationship between DDS and ICE.



Legal Support to Members

GLAHR provided community members with support regarding DACA. We sought to inform the community on the status of DACA and how to apply for it. We held DACA clinics to aid in renewals as well as individual appointments for renewals. This year we have been able to provide support for 40 DACA applications. GLAHR also provided legal support for members beyond DACA renewals. We provided support with work permits and immigration court proceedings. This year we supported 20 individuals.

Aplicantes de DACA por Primera Vez

Si estás interesado(a) en solicitar el DACA por primera vez, puedes ser elegible para solicitar el DACA si cumples con los requisitos. Le pedimos que comience a reunir los documentos que establecen su elegibilidad. Sin embargo, por favor espere hasta que la Administración Trump haya emitido una guía antes de presentar una solicitud. The hotline also serves as a source of information for GLAHR to stay informed on what is happening in the Latinx community around the state of Georgia.

Over the course of the year, we received a total of 2,089 calls from community members, many of these calls came from individuals detained in one of the four detention centers in Georgia in reference to the ill-treatment that individuals detained were facing with COVID-19. These calls also fueled our #FreeThemAll campaign and fed into our ICE Chasers' rapid-response team and GA Immigration Bond Fund.






Digital Communication

GLAHR's total Facebook outreach is 151,915 from January to July 2020, posts include civic engagement, calls to action, events, legislature/policy, and Black Lives Matter.



Social Media Campaign Stewart Detention Center

In collaboration with Georgia Detention Watch and Project South, we launched a "Social media storm" to bring the attention to the violence used in Stewart County Detention Center, and their Special Operations Response Team (SORT). Individuals Detained were physically and mentally hurt while refusing to eat as part of the hunger strike demanding their release due to the dangers of COVID-19.



GLAHR received around 47 family members and detainees' calls-complaints about the abuse they were going through, and Facebook posts showed how SORT members were boasting about the harm they caused among detainees. GLAHR, Georgia Detention Watch, and Project South, through The Intercept preformed an journalist investigation resulted in the firing of SORT members.

Community

For GLAHR, the well-being of the community has always been a priority. Our community activities are part of our organizing work to build relationships with the community through art and recreational activities. Therefore, we created GLAHR Guitarristas-, guitar classes for the community to unwind and hosted a community concert with Gabino Palomares, a singer/songwriter creator of the New Song movement whose focus is to empower those in the civil rights movement.

GLAHR was invited to participate in two workshops that dealt with the importance of mental health among activists, and the COVID-19 impact on Latinos in South Ga. The latter being called “Siéntase Seguro” (Feel Safe), focusing on the resources available to assist the immigrant community.

GLAHRTE

GLAHR's art, also known as GLAHRte, is used to amplify our campaigns and get our message across through art. Our art is featured at every rally, march, and event we attend and take the shape of banners, posters, graphics, painting, and in-house screen printing.

Art Day/ Art Video: Although we were not able to have a protest in response to Governor Kemp's claims, GLAHR hosted an "Art Day" as a way to come together and make art. We also created a "How To" art tutorial shared with Mijente and others that took a look at movement art.





Radio Migrante COMMUNITY RADIO

GLAHR hosts various radio shows to inform a broader audience on what is going on nationwide and locally in Georgia. We host a total of three different radio shows every week: GLAHRiador@s, Todas la Voces, and Chambeando. Each radio show touches on subjects and issues that are directly impacting the community.




